How to deal with your amphibian problem in the field?

- First, identify what species is causing the problem using this guide
- Second, employ a multifaceted approach to deal with the amphibian nuisance, including locating sensitive sites, monitoring, and exclusion
- Fences made of aluminum siding with a 10 cm overhanging lip at the top will prevent frogs from climbing over and are durable enough to withstand extreme weather, including 20 mph wind speeds
- Install this fence at wetland sites to hinder the movement of amphibians, with the direction that the lip faces will keep amphibians in or out of a site
